In these rules, we refer to the above promoter(s) as "the promoter(s)", or "us" or "we". We will refer to participants and winners as "you".

General	No correspondence will be entered into regarding either this Pilot or these Rules. In the unlikely event of a dispute, our decision shall be final. We reserve the right to amend, modify, cancel or withdraw any aspect of this Pilot in our sole discretion at any time without notice or liability. We cannot guarantee the performance of any third party and shall not be liable for any act or default by a third party. Participants in this Pilot agree that we will, subject to prevailing law, have no liability whatsoever for any injuries, losses, costs, damage or disappointment of any kind resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly from acceptance or from participation in this Pilot. The laws of the Republic of South Africa govern this Pilot. If any provision or part of these Rules is deemed void or otherwise unenforceable in law then that provision or part shall be deemed excluded and the remainder of these Rules shall remain in force. ## **IMPORTANT**
