Read these Competition rules carefully. These Competition rules ("rules") explain your rights and duties in connection with this Competition. Entries close:	Entries close on 09 December 2020 at 18:00 pm. The promoter(s) reserve the right to extend the Competition by amending these Competition rules.
Is there a limit on the number of times you can enter?	There is no limit on the number of entries. Every separate qualifying purchase from any Vision Works Store using your FNB/RMB PB card or eBucks will count as an entry into the draw.
Winner announced on:	The winner will be announced in the week commencing 21 December 2020
Eligibility: Who qualifies to take part?	This Competition is open to any legal resident of the Republic of South Africa who is a natural person, 18 years of age or older at the time of entry or juristic person. Excluding the categories of people listed below who cannot take part.
Who cannot take part?
