Read these competition rules carefully. These competition rules explain your rights and duties in connection with this competition. If you take part in this competition and/or accept any discount, these rules will apply to you and you agree that the promoter(s) can assume that you have read and agreed to be legally bound by these competition rules.

Competition Name:	Win a R2500 Makro Gift Card when you spend using your eBucks in-store or online.
Promoter(s) Name(s):	<p>This competition is run by FNB-eBucks, a business unit within FirstRand Bank Limited Registration No. 1929/001225/06 ("eBucks") having its principal place of business at 10th Floor, FNB Place, First National Bank, Bank City, 30 Diagonal Street, Johannesburg, Gauteng, South Africa, 2000, in collaboration with Makro. The person responsible for conducting the promotional competition on behalf of eBucks is Bruce Gibbs, a Partner Growth Manager at eBucks. In these rules, we refer to the above promoter(s) as "the promoter(s)", or "us" or "we". We will refer to participants as "you".</p> <p>For the purpose of this competition, "customer", "you", "participant" or "winner" means the natural person, whose name, contact telephone number and South African Identity number or valid passport number is reflected on the Makro SAP Customer Relationship Management system ("SAP CRM 7 system") at the time of the draw and whose details are attached to the Makro card used in conjunction with their eBucks or FNB card at any Makro store.</p>
The Competition:	<p>You as an eBucks member will automatically qualify to be entered into the draw to win a Makro gift card to the value of R2500 when you make a purchase either in-store at any Makro store or online at www.makro.co.za using your eBucks. NB: in order to qualify, only eBucks spend is permitted. Part-payment with Rands will not qualify you for entry into the competition.</p> <p>There will be a draw for the winner on 16 January 2018, and the winner will be announced and contacted after the draw has taken place.</p> <p>The prizes may not be sold or given to someone else and cannot be exchanged for cash or a different prize. Eligibility: Who qualifies to take part?	This competition is open to any legal resident of the Republic of South Africa who is a natural person, 18 years of age or older at the time of entry and is a member of the eBucks Rewards Programme.

	To be eligible to win the prize, it is necessary for you to transact within the Competition Period.
Exclusion/Who cannot take part?	<p>The following persons may not take part in this Competition even if they qualify to take part. They will forfeit (give up) any prizes awarded to them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Any employee of the promoter(s). b) Any director, member, partner, agent of, or consultant of the promoter(s). c) Any other person who is directly or indirectly controls the promoter(s). d) Any supplier of goods and services in connection with this Competition. e) The spouse, life partner, siblings, children, or parents of any of the persons named in a, b, c, or d above.
Is there a limit on the number of times you can enter?	There is no limit on the amount of entries. Each in-store or online purchase at www.makro.co.za using only your eBucks during the competition period will qualify as an entry into the competition.
How will the winner be announced?	<p>The winner will be announced via ebucks.com. The winner will be notified personally by eBucks directly within 48 hours of the draw taking place, and will be contacted either telephonically or via email.</p> <p>While prize winners may be asked to take part in publicity for the competition, prize winners have the right to refuse to do so.</p>
How will the winner be chosen?	<p>A random draw will take place on 16 January 2018 for the competition period. The random entry drawn will be checked to establish whether it meets the competition qualifying and eligibility criteria. The random draws will be overseen by the Legal Risk and Compliance team. If the eligibility and qualifying criteria are not met or if a potential winner cannot be contacted within 2 (two) days after the first attempt through no fault of eBucks, further random draws will take place for entries that meet the eligibility and qualifying criteria and this entry will be assessed as aforesaid by the panel of judges to determine the final winners.</p> <p>Should a winner be disqualified for any reason, a new winner will be re-drawn from the remaining participating entries in accordance with the same draw process as applicable to the original draw.</p>

IMPORTANT
